Illegally Deported U.S. Citizen Pedro Guzman Found After Nearly Three Months

LOS ANGELES – Pedro Guzman, the U.S. citizen illegally deported from a Los Angeles County jail nearly three months ago, has been found and is expected to be reunited with his family today. The ACLU of Southern California will hold a press conference today to discuss the details. A press release will be available at that time.

Mr. Guzman was deported to Tijuana on May 11 after immigration officials and jail personnel wrongfully identified him as a Mexican citizen. Guzman was born in L.A. The ACLU/SC went to court June 11 to seek government help in his safe return.
